THE SCHOOLS AGREEMENT

- Let you know of any problems or concerns which may affect your child's work or behaviour.

- Inform you of your child's progress at regular meetings.
- Maintain an open door policy to encourage good communication.
- To provide homework as laid out in the school's homework policy appropriate to the age of the child.
- To endeavour to listen to the concerns of children and guide appropriately.
