## MATHEMATICS

**Number/calculation** bonds to 10, 20, Year 2 up to 100. Counting in 2s, 5s, 10s using arrays and linking to the times tables. Positioning and recognising 2 digit numbers on number lines up to 100. Place value: read and write numbers in numerals up to 20, Year 2 up to 100.

### **Multiplication**

Year 1 counting in 2s, grouping maths apparatus and counting in 2ps in Money

Year 2 Recognising 2s 5s and 10s calculating the correct number sentences.

**Measurement** Linked to Goldfinches Woodland Workshop measuring and sorting materials for woodland shelters

Year 1 Comparing length and using maths vocabulary long short

Year 2 Beginning to use standard measurements in cm /m and ordering lengths using greater and lesser than symbols.
