Who's who?

Mrs Gilbert is the main class teacher in Robins, and Mrs Taylor is the Teaching Assistant who works for the majority of time in Robins. On Wednesdays Mrs Chudasama teaches in Robins with Mrs Pottinger as the TA (Teaching Assistant).

What about play?

Play is vital in Reception and Year 1. As well as developing independence pupils learn through a range off activities provided by us (adult initiated) or developed by themselves (child initiated). The Foundation stage (of which reception is the last year) is based around the four important principles of A UNIQUE CHILD, POSITIVE RELATIONSHIPS, ENABLING ENVIRONMENTS and LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT. All these areas are supported by play - hence why it is so important! In year 1 pupils DO NOT just stop developing in the above areas and that is why we offer our year 1 pupils daily play opportunities as well.
