We are inviting applications for a SEND Teaching Assistant/s, to assist with the education of children with autistic spectrum disorder (ASD) starting school in September (age 4). This is a fixed term contract dependent on the children being educated at our school. Applicants must be patient, adaptable and true team members. The role will include one to one/two work across the full curriculum and the personal care of the children.
