## ENGLISH

Looking at narrative. Work will be focussed around the novel Harry Potter for the first part of the term. We will also be focussing on Grammar sessions as we begin to look ahead in Year 6 to end of Year assessment tests.

## History

### At the Movies

Address and begin to devise valid questions about change, cause, similarity and difference and significance by learning about the role of cinema in 20th century entertainment. This is linked heavily to English work this term.

## FRENCH

Food. Learning new vocabulary to speak, hear and write.

## RE

Beliefs and moral values.

Key Question: Is anything ever eternal?

Religion focus: Christianity

## PSHCE

My Friends and Family

How people deal with sensitive issues such as self image, stereotyping and media influence. It looks at choices people make and their consequences.

## PE

Outside games sessions will continue with Mr Smith. Inside sessions will focus on dance sessions built around drama.

## Computing

### Scratch- Animated Stories

Pupils will be able to continue their skills in writing their own algorithms as well as editing and debugging existing codes.

## DT

### Marbulous Magical Structures

Looking at freestanding structures and how they can be strengthened and reinforced when constructing marble runs.

## MATHS

Maths work will continue looking at different areas of the curriculum as we delve deeper into the year 5 and 6 curriculum. Some areas of work covered will include Fractions, negative numbers, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, shape measure and data, percentages and mean and ratio.
