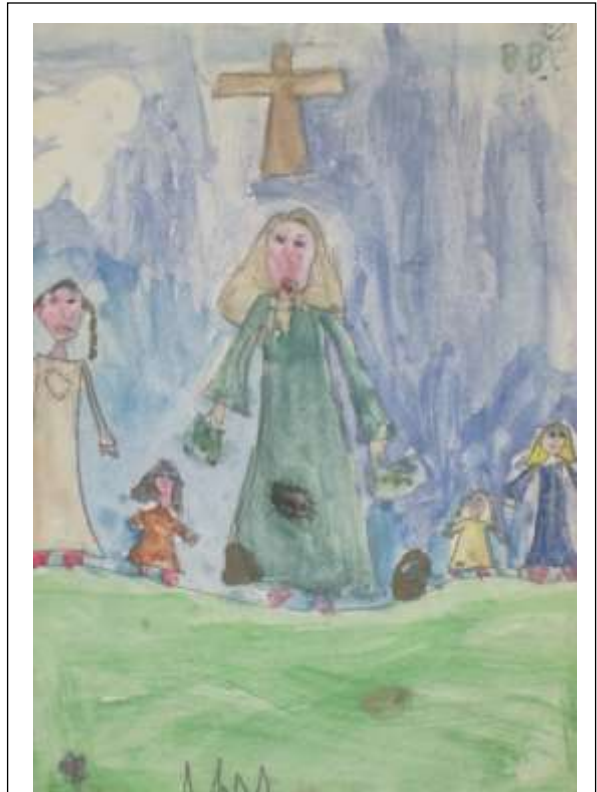
### EASTER
