A Child's War

Welcome to Term 1 and 2! In these notes you will find information relating to Kites class and a brief overview of some of the areas of study your child will be covering at school over the next two terms. Each 'big' term (autumn, spring and summer) we have a whole school topic that some activities might link to however some areas stand alone and could be inspired for example by a book, current world events or a place. For terms 1&2 our topic is 'A Child's War'.

Areas of Exploration

History

We will be looking at World War II and when and why it began. This will involve looking at the key individuals and countries involved. Kites will explore evacuation: learn what it was like to live with food rationing and explore the contribution made by women to the war effort.

Science

In term one we will be looking at climate change and the impact it is having around the world. We'll look at how humans have caused climate change and what we can do to stop it. In term two Kites will look at electricity, conduct their own investigations and learn about important scientific inventors.


PSHE

Kites will be looking at the positive qualities of a team, learning how to disagree respectfully and communicate effectively.

DT

We will be exploring and experimenting with a range of different structures, forces and components to build and test Anderson shelters.
