READING

SATS

Areas of Exploration

French

In French this term we will look at French festivals.

Science

English

In English we will start with narrative poetry, which will include The Listeners and several other wonderful classic poems. Children will learn about the explorer Captain Scott and write diaries in the voices of those on the ill-fated expedition.

History

Geography

Computing
